Educational Package Information

As Transylvania International School is a non-profit educational project, and the freedom to apply its philosophy means the absence of financial support from state funds, we must ensure a realistic balance between educational quality and internal needs. Therefore, our tuition plan aligns with our school's philosophy of maintaining an accessible yet sustainable financial framework.

- The financial contribution for 2025-2026 is annual and can be paid in one of two ways:
- A one-time annual payment, with a 5% discount if paid by August 25, 2025.
- 11 monthly installments, due on the 25th of each month, from August 25, 2025, to June 25, 2026.
- The annual contribution covers the cost of school supplies, textbooks, and educational platforms.
- The annual contribution does not include international testing fees for PSAT 8/9, PSAT, and SAT, nor the cost of the school uniform.
- The enrollment and U.S. accreditation fee is 1500 RON, payable upon signing the Educational Partnership Agreement. This fee covers:
 - The annual membership fee that TIS pays as an accredited NCPSA and ISEI institution.
 - Teacher certification in the USA.
 - The issuance of educational infrastructure documents.
- A 10% discount applies to the short or regular school program for siblings (second child, third child, etc.).
- A 10% discount applies to the short or regular school program for members of the Seventh-day Adventist Church (at least one parent), as per the financial support agreement from the church.
- The financial contribution for the Accelerated Learning Program for the 2025-2026 school year is 5000 RON.
- The list of workshops and after-school programs will be communicated at the beginning of the school year.
